**February 5, 2012 @ 9:21am** – Columbia County Deputy Sheriff's Brian Molinski and Peter Grzeskow arrested 46 year old Donna Kryzckowski of Maple Lane Livingston, NY on 5 counts of Issuing a Bad Check as well as an outstanding Bench Warrant from the Hudson City Court. Kryzckowski had issued 5 checks to a business in Elizaville, NY without sufficient funds to cover them in 2010. Her husband, 51 year old Joseph Kryzckowski also of Maple Lane, Livingston was arrested and charged with Obstructing Governmental Administration 2<sup>nd</sup> degree when he repeatedly lied to Deputy Sheriff's knowing his wife was wanted, telling Deputy Sheriff's that she was residing in another state. He was arraigned in the Livingston Town Court by Town Justice Robert Q. Moore, and remanded to the county jail in lieu of \$1,000.00 cash or \$2,500.00 bail bond. Donna Kryzckowski was also arraigned by Judge Moore and she too was remanded to the county jail in lieu of \$500.0 cash or \$1,000.00 bail bond. They will both return to the Livingston Town Court February 9<sup>th</sup> @ 7pm.

**January 26, 2012 @ 10:00am** – Columbia County Deputy Sheriff's Marcus Hickey and Peter Grzeskow arrested 27 year old Matthew R. Johnson of Elmwood Avenue Philmont, NY following a domestic incident. Johnson was taken into custody and charged with the class A-Misdemeanors of Criminal Obstruction of Breathing, Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Johnson engaged in a physical confrontation in the presence of his children. He was arraigned in the Claverack Town Court by Town Justice Michael Brandon, ror'd and ordered to return to town court February 16<sup>th</sup> @ 3pm.
